<i>Tasting Notes</i>	The 2009 Zinfandel has big, bright aromatics of raspberry, violet, mocha and cola. The youthful, chewy tannins are wrapped in a thick blanket of blackberry and plum. The addition of Petite Sirah adds tremendous weight and power to the wine. This is a Zin for the cellar that should last a good, long time. Drink 2012-2017.
