<i>Vintage Notes:</i>	The vintage of a lifetime. In 2023, Napa Valley experienced one of the longest growing seasons in a decade or more. With consistent, mild weather throughout the season, above-average crop yields from the abundant winter rains, and extended hang time, 2023 is an exceptional and memorable vintage.
<i>Wine Notes:</i>	This wine represents our beginnings, with the first vintage produced in 2002 and has been the foundation of our winery ever since. Above all, it is a pure expression of our combined palates and how our winemaking philosophy intersects with the climate, soil and topography that makes up the terroir of Napa Valley.
<i>Tasting Notes:</i>	Profound and dynamic fruit flavors of black raspberries, red currants and Damson plums combine with complex notes of licorice, pie crust and cocoa dust for a dense yet focused palate. A long and complex finish is framed by ripe and integrated tannins with a touch of minerality.
<i>Aging Advice:</i>	The classic growing season of the 2023 vintage produced wines, both white and red, that merit cellaring to allow the wine's complex character to be truly revealed. However, as with all of our portfolio, we strive to produce wines that have immediate enjoyment for those who prefer not to wait.
